



Kooyong Mornington Peninsula, Australia



In 1995, Kooyong was established on a gently undulating 93 hectare property neighbouring Devilbend Reserve, home to many native water birds. The Kooyong name means 'where the wild fowl gather'. The vineyard and winery are part of the Gjergja family domain which also includes Port Phillip Estate.

2006 Chardonnay

COLOR: Vibrant straw color

BOUQUET: Grapefruit and citrus aromas supported by mineral and savoury matchstick characters.

PALATE: The palate is linear with grapefruit and citrus flavours as well as stony, mineral characters and a nutty almond finish.

CELLARING With careful cellaring, this wine has good potential for ageing.

2006 Pinot Noir



\$54.95 (750ml x 6)

COLOR: Vibrant ruby red

BOUQUET: Dominated by red and black cherry with supporting earth and spice notes.

PALATE: Cherry and spice notes with pronounced minerality. Currently the wine is very youthful with bright acidity and supporting firm but very fine tannins. Showing plenty of promise for further development.
