Gigi Rosso's winery in Castiglione Falletto, the heart of the Barolo area, is the centre of vinification for the grapes which are grown on their four estates, each one a cru accurately selected from the exposures most profoundly given to vine growing among the hills of the Langhe.



2007 Dolcetto Diano d'Alba Vigna Vecchia del Pinnacolo DOC

A special reserve produced in very limited quantity from the Dolcetto grapes of the Pinnacolo Vineyard. These gnarled vines, more than half a century old, give this wine an extraordinary violet colour, a bouquet of forest flowers and an ample taste of berries and ripe fruit.

2007 Nebbiolo d'Alba Rocca-Giovino DOC

Just outside the Barolo and Barbaresco areas, Nebbiolo grapes of the Langhe and Roero districts make the basis for this noble wine, which proudly carries the name of its varietal. It is aged one year in oak barrels to reach its austere and dignified equilibrium. It has a dark ruby color, long-lasting and persuasive bouquet of forest flowers and dried herbs and full-bodied intense smooth flavour.

2004 Barolo Arione

Arione, is an historically important Barolo sub-zone, which consists of a single-vineyard owned entirely by Gigi Rosso. It is located in Serralunga d'Alba and vaunts an optimal Southern exposure. This vineyard, originally three hectares, was completely replanted by Gigi Rosso in the 1960s; one more hectare has since been acquired and replanted in 1995. The dry calcareous clay soil does not permit the production of large quantities of grapes. Thanks to such low production and hand selection, Barolo Arione achieves an extraordinary concentration of fruit which is complemented by its intense dried herb, mineral and earth character. The wine ages for three years in wood barrels before release.

2007 Roero Arneis

The Arneis grape variety takes its name from a word in Piedmontese dialect which means "whimsical", like the grapevines from this Roero Wine district. From the steep sandy vineyards of this zone comes this extraordinary wine, Roero Arneis, with its pale straw-like greenish color, very intense bouquet of forest flowers and poignant, persistent aroma with an almond-like backtaste. It is a white wine with great character, ideal as an apéritif or served with cold appetizers.
