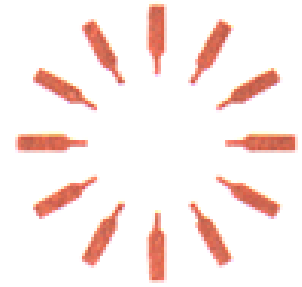

Verdejo, Sauvignon Blanc, and Viura.

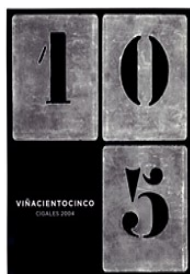

2007 Almuvedre, DO Alicante

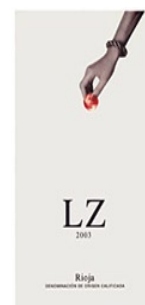
A terrific value is the 100% Mourvedre tank-aged cuvee, the 2007 Al Muvedre. It exhibits surprisingly sweet tannin (for a Mourvedre) along with loads of blueberry, cherry, and earthy notes. Unusually rich, medium-bodied, concentrated, and complex for a wine that has seen no wood, it should be consumed over the next 3-4 years.



2007 Viña 105, DO Cigales

Tempranillo and a small (10%) portion of Garnacha (Grenache) Cigales is known for its rosé wines so this wine is the same blend only darker. Forward modern fruit with a spicy twist. The palate is spicy and full with nice fruit quality.

2007 LZ, DO Rioja

A very fashionable, juicy and lush un-oaked Rioja with expressive flavours of dark and red berry fruit and a typical, slightly gamey nose surrounded by hints of plums.

2006 Gazur, DO Ribera del Duero

A sensational bargain from Ribera del Duero, the deep ruby-hued Gazur is a fleshy, modern-styled, 100% tank-fermented and aged Tinto Fino (Tempranillo). A pure, delicious, exuberant Spanish red boasting copious quantities of black currant and cherry fruit intermixed with licorice and strawberry characteristics, it is a fruit-filled, dry, bistro red with plenty of soul.

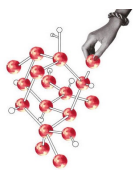

2005 Lanzaga, DOC Rioja

Seductively perfumed nose shows suave, oak-spiced strawberry and cherry. Spicy red fruit flavors are sweetened by vanilla and mocha. Turned firmer with air and picked up deeper cherry and cassis notes. Finishes round, supple and sweet, with a repeating mocha impression.

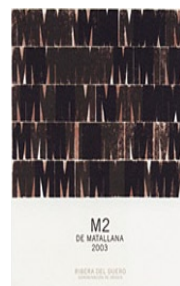

The 2006 Altos de Lanzaga is a beautiful Rioja offering soft tannin, low acidity, and round, generous, black cherry and roasted herb notes intermixed with notions of cedar as well as toasty oak.

2005 M2 De Matallana, DO Ribera Del Duero

Elegant, complex, finesse-styled. Notes of sweet pipe tobacco intermixed with licorice, black currants, cherries, and spice box emerge from this medium-bodied, delicately nuanced wine. It should drink well young, yet age nicely for 7-8 years given its impeccable balance.
